For dog walkers and ramblers there are many 'walk-to' treks including the Hicca Way along the River Purwell and up West Drive to Fairfield Park and around the perimeters of the old lagoons.

Letchworth mainline station (direct London Kings Cross 36 mins) 3.3 miles





Location

Arlesey is a large village just North of the Beds/Herts border, surrounded by countryside yet within easy reach of the A507 and A1(M). The village offers a range of local shopping, pubs and food outlets and significantly a Mainline Railway station with direct travel to London St. Pancras in under 40 minutes. Dating back as long as the 1086 Domesday Book, there is a broad range of home styles and building eras - something for everyone! Gothic Mede Academy provides Primary education in the middle of the village, with numerous Secondary options including Etonbury Academy on the Arlesey/Stotfold border. Further facilities and shopping are available within a few miles in the larger towns of Letchworth Garden City and Hitchin to the South.
