This spacious 1 bedroom apartment is on the first floor of Crown Lodge, an attractive small development with a private car park and very close to local shopping facilities in this growing village with it's own mainline railway station direct to London St Pancras.

The property has been well maintained and the lease was recently extended, now approx 189 years remaining! Current monthly service/block insurance/ground rent is approx £65.

Accommodation includes an entrance hall, a roomy open-plan living space incorporating the kitchen, double bedroom and refitted bathroom.

The Living Room is light and bright with large sliding glass doors with a glass shield outside to create a Juliet balcony. Kitchen has plenty of cupboards and extensive worksurfaces including a peninsular section as a possible breakfast bar. Oven and hob are built in.

The bedroom is at the back of the building, away from the road, and has an excellent range of fitted wardrobes and cupboards.

Bathroom has been refitted, all tiled, including a wide shower enclosure with overhead rainshower, vanity basin and WC. Electric towel rail and an opening window are bonuses.

The property has one allocated parking space plus there is an overflow car park with further spaces for visitors.

Location


